Various industry studies estimate billions a year in lost profits. Taxes that are not collected on sales made outside of legal channels, result in millions in lost tax revenue as well.

At the same time as the secondary markets have flourished, there has been an increase in consumer demand for some hard-to-find alcohol products - wines, scotch whiskies and more recently bourbons. In addition to the unlicensed resale of legitimate products, counterfeiters are taking advantage of online secondary markets.

International secondary markets have seen many cases of poisonous, tainted alcohol. Is it inevitable that tainted alcohol hits the illegal US secondary markets as well?
