SESSION #9: INTERSECTION OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGE AND CANNABIS

Cannabis is becoming legal in more and more states every year and businesses in each industry are looking at ways to come or work together. This panel will look at the various ways that the alcohol beverage and cannabis industries intersect both from the perspective of how laws and regulations for the two industries compare as well as how regulators, particularly those with dual responsibilities, address the complex issues raised by these two products. The panel will provide a basic introduction to cannabis laws and regulation, both existing and proposed and consider federal and state permitting and licensing regulations in states where both the sale and distribution are currently lawful. The panel will include both industry participants and former and current state regulators. Ultimately, our panelists will debate the question, "Should cannabis be regulated like alcohol beverages?"
